Chandra Muller is Associate Professor of Sociology at the University of Texas at Austin. Her current research is on the influence of family, community, education policy and health behaviors on adolescent academic achievement and post secondary education. Dr. Muller is the principal investigator of the Adolescent Health and Academic Achievement (AHAA) study which is collecting high school transcripts for Add Health Wave III respondents and, thus, will provide rich data on students' academic experiences, opportunities, and stratification.
